When David first informed us of his call to Baltimore, the last vestry immediately met to begin to discuss the process by which we would call Holy Trinity's next rector. You may recall that we discussed that process with Mary Hays of the Diocese of Pittsburgh at our All Parish Forum in January. As we moved forward, however, we realized that vestry elections were just a couple of weeks away, and we felt it was important to have the input of four newly elected vestry members - chosen by our congregation during this period of significant transition - who presumably would reflect the most current perspective of our church body. Since the election two weeks ago, the new vestry has been primarily focused on this important issue. We look forward to providing you with a more detailed update during the next few weeks.
